
Not automatically

conveyable parcels (NC)





A parcel is classed as not automatically conveyable if it cannot be sorted via the DPD conveyor systems due to its shape or dimensions. A surcharge may be imposed for these parcels due to the special handling which is required. This overview provides you with details of parcels that are not automatically conveyable.

Girth:	< 300 cm

Not automatically conveyable parcels

Dimensions	Volume	Excess size, weight or length
Length: 121-175 cm	> 150 litres	Lenght: 176-250 cm
Width: > 60 cm		Girth: 301-330 cm
Height: > 60 cm		Weight: > 31.5 kg

Girth and volume calculator:

Girth: 2 x Height [cm] x 2 x Width [cm] + longest side [cm]

Volume: Length a [cm] x Length b [cm] x Length c [cm]/1000
